There once was a ship put out to sea, the name of the ship was the Bill-y o' Tea. The winds blew up, her



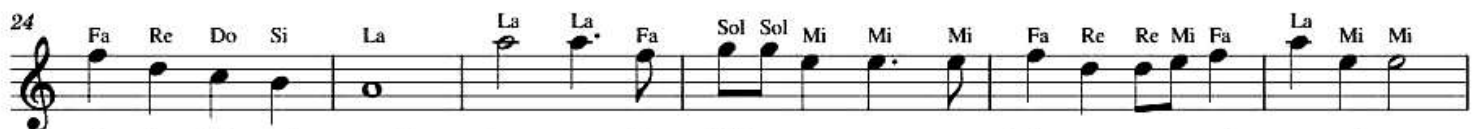
